**COSTS:**

**CLINIC FEES:** \$40 for XC/Jump Clinic (groups of no more than 5), and \$45 Dressage – 45 minute private

**DERBY PLAYDAY & HUNTER PACE:** \$20 per class, dressage, jumping, or hunter pace track

**DERBY:** \$45.00 per division includes a dressage ride & jumping round. Additional Dressage or jump rounds \$25.00 per ride.

**GROUNDS FEE:** \$10 per day – must be paid if riding on the site

**STABLING:** \$15 per day

**3 April 2010 - DERBY PLAY DAY – EVENTING ALA CARTE CLASSES**

Class 1) Ride and Review Dressage test: Choose any 2010 USEA test of your choice to ride in a small arena. New this year: Preliminary and Intermediate Tests will ride in a large arena on the grass. Receive verbal comments from the judge immediately following your test.

Class 2) Jumping test over a derby course: Choose which level (Intro through Prelim) to jump over a derby course similar to the one used in the following days jackpot competition. Course will include show jumps and cross country fences.

Class 3) Hunter Pace trek: Course will be approx. 2 miles in length and will consist of several optional jumps including ditches, banks, and water. Course will be flagged and numbered, all flags are mandatory. Prizes will be awarded based on which rider is closest to the optimum time a huntsman with hounds would complete the same course (approx. 300 mpm). **Due to popular demand, the hunter pace trek will be open, visited by the Easter Bunny and available to enter on Sunday as well.**

Class 4) Hunter Pace team: Same as class 3 except a team of 2 – 4 riders will compete over the course. Time will start when the first rider crosses the start line and ends when the last horse finishes. All horses must complete the course for a qualifying time. Horse and rider pairs should ride approx 1 – 2 horse lengths apart the length of the course.

#### 4 April 2010 - DERBY DIVISIONS OFFERED:

HUNTER PACE – Course will be open until noon. Same rules as above. Easter Eggs on route..

INTRO Beginning Novice - Dressage Test: 2010 USEF Beg. Novice Test A (test may be read)  
Jumping Course: 12" - 24", approx. 12-16 obstacles (water and ditches optional) approx. 500-900 meters in length, speed 250 mpm.

Beginner Novice - Dressage Test: 2010 USEF Beg. Novice Test B (test may be read). Jumping course: to 2' 7", approx. 12-16 obstacles (water and ditches optional), approx. 600-900 meters in length, 300 mpm.

Novice - Dressage Test: 2010 USEF Novice Test A. Jumping course 2' 11". Approx. 14-16 obstacles, approx. 700-1000 meters in length, speed 325 mpm.

Training - Dressage Test: 2010 USEF Training Test A. Jumping course: 3' 3". Approx. 16-18 obstacles, approx. 800-1200 meters in length, speed 350 mpm.

Preliminary - Dressage Test: 2010 USEF Preliminary Test A. Jumping course: 3' 7". Approx. 15-20 obstacles, approx. 900-1300 meters in length, speed 375 mpm.

Intermediate – Dressage Test of Choice, 2010 USEF A or B. No Jumping Offered, Sorry.

\* Jumping rounds may be post entered, but please be available to go once the course is in use.

- **Competitors are encouraged to enter more than one division.**
- **All dressage tests ridden in small arena on sand.**
- **Eventing Rules will be closely followed.**
- **Acceptable Attire: Shirts with collars, breeches, boots and helmets w/ chinstrap.**
- **Refunds: Before closing date, less \$20 office fee. No refunds after closing date.**
